INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 TENTH round of counselling and admissions will be held on 4th September 2017.
2 The candidates have to report between 10 AM and 11 AM on the above date for Counselling as per the **Merit Rank** in the Final General Merit List

- 3 Only those who report for Counselling will be considered for Admissions to be held at 11 AM on the same date.
4 Latecomers will not be considered.
5 Admissions will be according to merit until the seats remain vacant in the respective categories.
6 Candidates who remain absent at the time of counselling will not be entertained for further rounds.
7 The candidates having *Merit Rank* higher than the rank at which the admission closes (in their respective category) will be eligible for admission in the subsequent rounds.
8 Following original documents are required for verification at the time of admission (with three sets of photocopies)
- Mark-sheet of 10th standard
 - Mark-sheet of 12th standard
 - School / College leaving certificate (TC)
 - Gap Certificate (if applicable)
 - Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - Non Creamy Layer Certificate (if applicable) (must for OBC/ SBC/ VJ/ NT B/ NT C/ NT D category)
 - Caste Validity Certificate (if applicable)
 - Aadhar Card
 - Voter Id (if available)
 - Migration and Eligibility Certificate (for CBSE, ISC and all Other State Boards)

- 9 Candidates should carry atleast 4 passport size photographs with them.
10 Admitted students need to submit fees in the form of a Demand Draft (D.D.) drawn at any nationalized bank in favour of,

"Director, Institute of Forensic Science, Nagpur"

payable at Nagpur.

 - For students who have passed XIIth from CBSE, ISC other State Boards:
